Synod News



On the 18th the Moderator had the joy and privilege of attending a special service celebrating the renewal of the Covenant between the Churches on the Hill in Amersham. He was signatory to the revised Covenant along with other Denominational Leaders.

The service was held at Amersham Free Church, a joint URC/Baptist Church which has also in recent years welcomed Methodist members following the closure of their local Church.

The ecumenical theme was interwoven in the Communion service with hymns by Nick Fawcett (Baptist) and John Campbell (URC) and a hymn tune written by Rachel Hewett (from the local Anglican Church) to accompany Summoned by God who Made Us. The preacher was Revd Tim Norwood, National Ecumenical Officer for the Church of England.



Art in Plain Sight

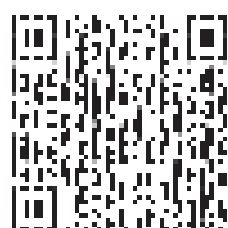

Secondary Education

- The Milton Mount Foundation offers means-tested bursaries to assist with the cost of secondary school fees to the children of Congregational and URC ministers, and also to the daughters of members of these churches.

Subject to the availability of sufficient funds, it may also be possible to provide grants to assist with the cost of school uniform and educational trips for ministers' children at both state and fee-paying schools.

Higher Education

- Grants are offered to daughters of Congregational and URC ministers **starting their first undergraduate degree** in autumn 2026. Grants are also offered to those beginning a **first postgraduate degree**, for up to three years. Subject to sufficient funds being available, similar grants may also be available for sons of ministers.

Temporary Lumen Centre Manager

Thames North Synod are looking to recruit an innovative and inspiring person to manage the Lumen Centre as a key resource facility for the Synod and to grow a Christian presence and witness there as we continue to develop a vision for the building.

The Lumen Centre is located in Central London (Tavistock Place). The Lumen Centre is a building that is strategically situated to play a key role in the development of the surrounding community, building bridges with local people and other churches as well as offering opportunities for worship and discipleship.

The postholder will have responsibility for overseeing the running and use of the building, and will work closely with the Synod Discipleship Enabler, Training Officer, Children and Youth Development Officer and other Synod staff members to make the most effective use of the building for the Synod. They will also help to continue to grow a Christian presence and witness.

This is a full-time post (37.5 Hours) requiring some flexibility in the pattern of hours worked, with a fixed term contract of 2 years at a salary of circa £35,000 - £40,000 per annum based on experience.

In accordance with the Equality Act 2010: Part 1, Schedule 9, there is a genuine occupational requirement for the post holder to be a practising Christian.
