Sunday Story: Jazz Vespers



Our monthly Jazz Vespers services started in the autumn of 2022 as a way to connect with people in the area during the week, but not on weekends. The service has steadily grown a consistent congregation of jazz fans, spiritual seekers and local workers, matching our Sunday morning attendance numbers. But June 2025 was record-breaking!

We partnered with the URC Thames North Synod, who provided a generous grant for musicians and sent singers from churches across the region. A mass choir of more than 40 people joined a professional big band of 15 musicians to perform Duke Ellington's Second Sacred Concert. Jared Jaggers and Scott Stroman craft a beautiful service every month.

The event drew 227 people! In addition to the 55 performers, there were probably 40-50 visitors from across the URC Synod. A small number were AIC members, but most were members of our regular jazz vespers community, or newcomers just trying things out for the first time.

AIC's investment in this programme has already resulted in several regular participants in our wider community, and our jazz vespers community continues to grow. Praise God!
