Message from the Green Apostles Big Butterfly Count 2025



Following the results of the Big Butterfly Count 2024, Butterfly Conservation have declared a butterfly emergency, and need our help. Can you take part in Butterfly Conservation's Big Butterfly Count 2025 to help assess the present situation, simply by counting butterflies? All you need to do is choose a place to spot butterflies on any day between 18 July and 10 August, then watch for 15 minutes and record what you see. There is a butterfly ID chart on the Butterfly Conservation website to help in identifying what you see. Then you can add your count, either on the website or the app. They also have an interactive map showing how the data adds to the overall picture. It doesn't take long to do but is tremendously helpful. Last year 85000 people submitted counts. Hopefully there'll be even more counts this year.
