

<u>Temporary instructions regarding governing document questions - for URC charities</u> <u>applying to register</u>

At the point in the application form where you are asked about your governing document you will need to

1) Select 'other' when asked "Select the organisation's governing document type":



2) You will then need to attach a PDF copy of the approved statement of the trusts of the local church working funds either the elders model or the non-elders model as appropriate:




3) then click continue

4) You will then be asked questions about the organisation's name, complete these as normal until you get to the following screen on structure and purposes:


When asked "What is the organisation's governing document?" copy and paste the following text into the form:

TRUSTS DISTILLED FROM THE UNITED REFORMED CHURCH ACTS (1972 AND 1981) AND SCHEME OF UNION (1972)



- 5) Then enter the date the organisation's governing document come into effect this will be individual to your organisation it is the date the document was adopted.
- 6) The next question asks you to enter the organisation's purposes (also known as objects) as they are written in the governing document. Please copy and paste the following text in to the form:

The object of the Charity is the advancement of the Christian faith for the benefit of the public in accordance with the Scheme of Union of the United Reformed Church



7) You can then proceed to complete the remainder of the form as normal
