DEATHS

Revd Donald Macarthur died, aged 91, on 14 August 2024. Donald was born on 7 May 1933 and leaves his wife Pat. He was minister at St Margaret's Presbyterian Church (now URC/Moravian) at Harlesden 1963-69 and St Andrew's Frognal between 1987-2017. In July last year the Moderator presented Donald with a certificate recognising 60 years since his ordination.

Revd Greta Morgan died peacefully at home on 24 July 2024 at the age of 95. She was the widow of a URC minister who served at Askew Road URC and was Interim Moderator there (from January/February 1986 to end August 1987) before his induction. She also served in Birmingham District between 1981-83 and Central London District from 1983-98. She leaves a son and daughter, Jon and Ghislaine.

John Wheatley, a longtime member of Bromley-by-Bow URC, died on 11 September 2024. He attended from way back in the 1950's and served as Church Secretary, Treasurer and Synod Representative for many years, indeed until he died.
