On 9th July 2025, over 5,000 people came together at Westminster to call on MPs to act now for a healthier, fairer, safer future. It was one of the biggest moments for climate and nature this year, and the largest mass lobby of the decade.

Representatives of The URC and Thames North Synod took part in the Faith Photocall at The Climate Coalition Mass Lobby. Some of them were able to meet with their MP and were invited to ask them to back bold, practical action by committing to:

- 1. Deliver vital funding to communities hit hardest by climate change here and around the world
- 2. Cut bills, back UK jobs, and secure a greener fairer future for all
- 3. Restore nature to create a safer, healthier future

# **Death of Keith Webster**

It is with sadness that we record the death of Keith Webster, who passed away on 2 July after a long battle with cancer.

Keith was a member of Chesham URC for over 40 years, serving as an elder, with terms as Treasurer and Church Secretary. He was also very active in the wider church, taking on the roles of Secretary and President of Chiltern District Council in the 1990s. He was for a number of years the Convenor of Synod Executive and accompanied the Moderator on a visit to India in January 2009.

At Assembly level he served on various committees including MIND, Stewardship Sub-Committee, Mission Council and latterly as Convenor of HRAG.

He died peacefully at home, surrounded by family.
