
Faith-motivated. Science-informed. Hope-inspired.

LCRF awards grants of up to £1,000 every Spring and Autumn to multiple refugee projects across London for the relief of destitution such as by the purchase of phone credit, travel cards, hygiene items, nappies, and food, and for emergency payments, to give to the thousands of destitute asylum-seekers in London who come to them for help. LCRF grants cannot be used for course fees, rent, or ongoing costs. LCRF does not make grants directly to individuals.

**For Spring 2025 applications,** the maximum grant an organisation can apply for is £1,000. As before, applications may be scaled back if

resources are insufficient. The Fund's Objects require us to support only work with destitute refugees and asylum-seekers in the London area.

Round 38 (Spring 2025) Our Spring round is now open. You may also sign up for our email list to receive information including when the grants round is open. The application closing date is Monday 5 May to be sent to grants@lcrf.org.uk. Please DO NOT SEND APPLICATIONS TO INDIVIDUAL TRUSTEES.

Please download and read the Guidance Notes and Terms & Conditions carefully before completing your downloaded application form.

The forms can be accessed via the link below, and you must use our latest form to apply. Please note that we require Safeguarding Policies to be submitted for review at least every TWO years. If the last time you sent us your policy was before the Spring 2022 application round, you must send an updated one this time. If you have updated your safeguarding policy in the last two years, please send us the latest one.




Three-year fixed-term, £16 per hour. Responsible to the Minister, working with him, Elders and volunteer members.
