## **Listed Places of Worship**

Those of you managing the repair and maintenance of Listed Places of Worship need to be aware that the £42 million Government Listed Places of Worship Grant Scheme has undergone a digital transformation with the development of a new website and application portal.

o The new website makes it easier to navigate and find the information - from scheme eligibility to application guidance. The website sits on the gov.uk domain, providing reassurance this is an official and trusted website.

o The new application portal will enable applicants to apply

online. This will follow the same familiar format as the PDF form, but will be easier to process than downloading and completing a physical document.

The option to use the old PDF will remain, but the application portal is planned to be more efficient - with all the information and attachments uploaded and submitted in one place.

The Lumen Community is a contemporary Christian community space provided by the Thames North Synod of the United Reformed Church in the heart of London. We offer you the opportunity to support the development of an exciting service to residents, guests, and various ministries of the Synod. You will be part of a caretaking team consisting of two posts, working flexibly for 15 hours at weekends.

Usual working hours will be flexible according to service needs: (for guidance only)
Tuesday 1800 -2130 (or 0530 - 0900)
Wednesday 1800 -2130 (or 0530 - 0900)
Saturday 0900 - 1630.

The caretaking team will ensure that the Lumen building is maintained to the highest standard, and will help provide our guests with a safe, comfortable, and pleasant experience while using our facilities. You will also be responsible for maintaining all records in accordance with Synod policies, procedures, and guidelines. The main duties of the role are:

- Opening and locking the building daily, providing weekend cover
- Cleaning
- Event preparation
- Simple repairs

The above list of duties is not exhaustive and may change according to service needs. Proven experience as a caretaker/janitor/handyperson within a similar environment would be a strong advantage.
